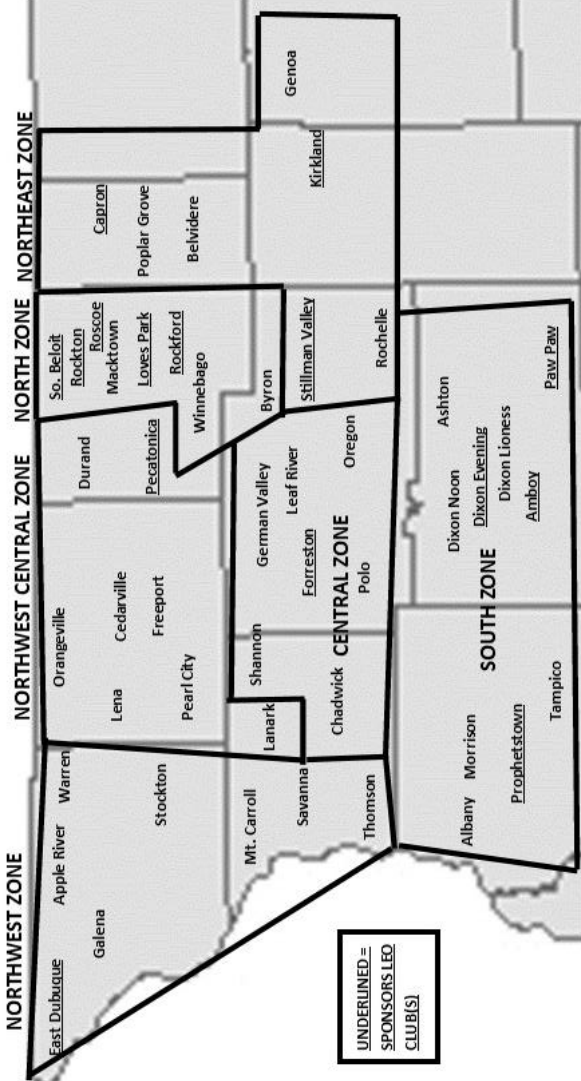

KEEPING MEMBERS IN YOUR CLUB

If your club is losing members, there are logical reasons. Part of this entire problem is that you will never know for sure what all these reasons are. This means that you should have an overall, ongoing strategy that is always working for your club in preventing membership drops no matter what the particular problem is. Here are some proven guidelines for you to consider implementing:

1. Prevent your members from ever thinking their evening was wasted by making the meeting interesting to as many members as possible.
2. Insist that your club funds are put to work. Lions who raise money and pay dues want to see results for their efforts.
3. Publicize your projects and contributions to people in need. Every Lion needs to feel pride not only in his/her own accomplishments, but in his/her own club as well. He/she will feel this pride much more if he/she knows the community knows what has been done.
4. Determine today that you are going to put all of your club members to work. Look who has been waiting for a long time to do something meaningful for the club.
5. Make your new member induction ceremonies full of the zeal and spirit of Lionism. Let there be no doubt that this event

is a very important step in this person's life.

Ask your older, dedicated members to participate in making this a memorable night.

6. Do not allow the sponsors of your club's new members to drop out of their responsibilities. Make sure they continue to look after the well-being of the member that sponsored. This is especially important during the new member's first two years. Remember one of the main reasons the new member joined was the relationship with the sponsor.
7. Finally, remember that Lions most frequently drop out because they are underworked and not involved. Their talents and potential contributions to the club have been sadly unrecognized by the club leadership.

5. YOU must complete 3 of the following:
 - a. Personally sponsor one new member to be inducted prior to June 30 of current fiscal year.
 - b. Attend District training for Presidents for current fiscal year.

 - d. Tour the Center for Sight & Hearing for current fiscal year or make a minimum donation of \$50 to CSH.
 - e. Attend at least one District, State or International Convention prior to or during your President's term.
6. Eligibility requires recommendation by the Zone Chairperson and must be certified by the District Governor.
