## GOVERNOR'S CORNER

#### Greeting 1-D Lions,

WOW, what a hurricane season. Many of you are wondering how you can help. I just this week got a request for help via the New Bern Lions and PDG Bob Block Jr.

I am in touch with the Council Chair in MD-35 (Florida) and have information on how we can help in the aftermath of Hurricane Milton. District I (Southwest Florida) was the hardest hit and below you can find the link to donate via credit card, debit card or PayPal. This will go straight to District I. I am currently in the process of arranging transportation for supplies to Florida, utilizing either a semi or box trucks. I will be reaching out to each of the Zone Chairs to identify a club in their zone willing to accept donations. Once identified, we will collect these donations and load them onto the trucks.

At this stage, I'm awaiting further logistical details, specifically the timeframe for our entry and the exact drop-off locations in Florida. As you can imagine, coordinating these efforts on both ends involves several moving parts. Additionally, I've been asked if our Lions would be able to assist with cleanup and distribution efforts once the roads and towns are reopened. If anyone is willing to volunteer to go to Florida and help, please let me know. I, along with my fellow Governors, will add you to the list and contact you when they are ready for us.

All District Governors received an email from PID Bob Block on Tuesday stating that they need blankets (military type as they need to be portable and easy to store) and sleeping bags (military style). Yesterday, we received an update requesting coloring books and crayons, playing cards, and things that will keep kids and the elderly busy. I spoke with PID Bob just a little bit ago, and he mentioned you can call his son, PDG Lion Bob Block Jr (New Bern Lions Club) at 252.229.5099 for further coordination. The procedure for financial donations seems to be in process of completion.

Thank you for your patience and support as we work through these logistics. I will keep everyone updated as soon as more information becomes available. Meanwhile, I will be working on having supply donation drop-offs lined up and ready to go as soon as I get the word.





#### Childhood Cancer Facts

 $\cdot$  More than 40,000 children undergo cancer treatment each year.

 $\cdot$  The average age at diagnosis is 6 years old

 $\cdot$  There are 16 major types of pediatric cancers and over 100 subtypes. The causes of most childhood cancers are unknown

• About 9,620 children in the United States under the age of 15 will be diagnosed with cancer in 2024.

 $\cdot$  Childhood cancer research is vastly and consistently underfunded.

 $\cdot$  Childhood cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children under the age of 15 in the U.S.

#### Survival rates for children with cancer

· Cancer incidence rates in children overall have stabilized since 2015, after increasing since at least 1975.

 $\cdot$  Because of major treatment advances in recent decades, about 85% of children with cancer now live 5 years or more after being diagnosed with cancer.

The cancer death rate has declined by more than half from 1970 to 2021 in both children and adolescents, largely due to improvements in treatment and high participation in clinical trials.

#### The cancer treatment team

Children with cancer and their families have special needs that can best be met at children's cancer centers. Treatment of childhood cancer in these centers is coordinated by a team of experts who know the differences between adult and childhood cancers, as well as the unique needs of children with cancer and their families. This team usually includes:

Pediatric oncologists: doctors who use medicines to treat children with cancer

Pediatric surgeons: doctors who perform surgery in children

Radiation oncologists: doctors who use radiation to treat cancer Pediatric oncology nurses: nurses who specialize in caring for children with cancer Nurse practitioners (NPs) and physician assistants (PAs): nurses and other health

 $\cdot$  A family experiences many emotions following a diagnosis. Providing them with resources is the first step to building a strong support system.

 $\cdot$  My DG Project will provide financial help to the organizations on the other side of this flyer
